

## LENNOX COMMUNITY TRAFFIC SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

### Scope of Work

The project consists of the implementation of pedestrian safety improvements on Hawthorne Boulevard, Inglewood Avenue, and Lennox Boulevard, roadway segments identified as Vision Zero Collision Concentration Corridors in the County's Vision Zero Action Plan.

Public Works will implement enhancements aimed at enhancing safety and improving walkability to schools, parks, libraries, and other community points of interest.

The project will be implemented in two phases.

- Phase I: Installation of “quick-build” enhancements including high-visibility crosswalks, paint/delineator curb extensions, and pedestrian signal timing.
- Phase II: Conversion of “quick-build” enhancements to permanent, which will include concrete curb extensions, Americans with Disabilities Act curb ramps and sidewalks, and traffic signal upgrades.

### Schedule/Status\*

#### Phase I

Spring 2025 – Onboard design consultant. Preliminary design

Winter/spring 2026 – Complete design plans

Fall 2026 - Installation of enhancements begins\*\*

### Estimated Costs/Funding Source

Phase I – The total project cost is \$1,141,000, funded through California Active Transportation Program – Cycle 6 to implement Phase I.
